

Overview of Our American High School Diploma

Northview offers a WASC-accredited American High School Diploma, ensuring students meet international university entrance requirements. The diploma certifies the completion of core academic subjects and elective courses, equipping students with critical thinking, creativity, and problem-solving skills essential for success in higher education and future careers.

- A WASC-accredited school is one that has earned recognition from the Western
 Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) for meeting high standards of
 educational quality and effectiveness. This accreditation assures parents that the
 school is dedicated to excellence in teaching, learning, and student support.
- WASC accreditation is a mark of trust. It means the school undergoes regular, indepth evaluations to ensure it is continuously improving and focused on student achievement. Accredited schools are committed to setting clear goals, listening to their communities, and making thoughtful, strategic changes that benefit all learners.



Graduation Requirements

To earn an American high school diploma at Northview, students must complete a minimum of 25 credits, maintaining at least a 60% passing grade. Our credit system follows the Carnegie Unit standard. A full-year course that meets four times a week earns one credit, while courses that meet less frequently earn partial credit based on instructional time.

- Core coursework in English, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and Foreign Language
- Electives that allow students to explore specialized interests
- Completion of one of the following external exams: SAT (minimum 400 in Math and Language), ACT (minimum score of 16), or two AP exams with a score of 3 or higher
- Senior Capstone Project as part of the Senior Seminar course



Course of Study

Northview's American curriculum is designed to provide students with a strong academic foundation while fostering creativity, critical thinking, and real-world application of knowledge. Our curriculum follows internationally recognized frameworks, ensuring students receive a globally competitive education that prepares them for university and beyond: English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies and Foreign Languages.

Advanced Placement (AP) & Honors Courses

Northview International School offers Advanced Placement (AP) and Honors courses to challenge high-achieving students and provide them with the opportunity to earn college credits while in high school. AP courses are designed to follow a university-level curriculum, with students sitting for AP exams at the end of the course.

AP Course Offerings:

- AP English Literature & Composition
- AP Calculus AB & BC
- AP Biology & AP Chemistry

- AP U.S. History & AP Government
- AP Computer Science

AP courses follow a 5.0 GPA scale, and successful completion of AP exams can strengthen university applications. Honors courses are available for students who wish to take on an advanced curriculum before progressing to AP-level coursework. These courses are weighted on a 4.5 GPA scale, providing an academic challenge while preparing students for higher education.





Customized Learning & Elective Opportunities

At Northview, students have the flexibility to personalize their academic journey through a wide range of electives and specialized learning pathways. These offerings enable students to explore their interests, develop essential skills, and prepare for future academic and career pursuits. Whether focusing on STEM, the arts, business, humanities, or physical education, students have the opportunity to create a well-rounded and competitive academic profile.

Academic Pathways

Core Courses

English




Mathematics

Mathematics courses at Northview develop students' problem-solving abilities, logical reasoning, and quantitative literacy. The curriculum covers foundational courses such as Algebra and Geometry, progressing to Pre-Calculus, AP Calculus, and AP Statistics. These courses equip students with the necessary skills for careers in engineering, finance, computer science, and other quantitative fields.

Science

Northview offers a rigorous, inquirybased science curriculum aligned with Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS). Students explore fundamental scientific principles in Biology, Chemistry, and Physics, engaging in laboratory experiments, field studies, and research projects. AP Science courses provide an advanced study of scientific disciplines, challenging students to think critically and apply their knowledge to real-world problems.







Social Studies

Social Studies courses aim to develop global awareness, historical knowledge, and civic responsibility. Students study World History, U.S. History, and Government and Politics, examining the connections between historical events and contemporary global issues. AP options such as AP U.S. History and AP Government allow students to delve deeper into complex political and social structures.

Foreign Languages

To promote linguistic proficiency and cultural literacy, we offer Arabic and Spanish as foreign language options. Arabic is a required course for students planning to attend universities in the Middle East and North Africa, and it is compulsory for all Muslim students throughout all four years of high school. Language courses emphasize oral communication, reading comprehension, and writing skills, ensuring students develop fluency and an appreciation for different cultures.



STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics) Initiatives




